The Council for Exceptional Children North Carolina Division on Career Development and Transition (CEC – NCDCDT) is proud to announce that it will be sponsoring the CEC – NCDCDT ***Lighthouse Award*** to recognize outstanding service in the field of Transition. The award will be given to ***an individual or group*** that has made a difference through commitment and dedication to ensuring that all students with disabilities in North Carolina make a successful transition from school to adult life. ***Nominees*** for the award may be a Principal, Central Office Personnel, Adult Service Providers, Business Leaders, Civic Groups, Parents, Post-Secondary Educators, Transition Coordinators or Teachers.

Any interested individual may submit one or more nominations. Nominations will be accepted by the CEC – NCDCDT through March 12, 2010. Nominations will be reviewed and judged by the Executive Board of the CEC – NCDCDT. Decisions made by these elected officers will be final.

The person making the nomination will be notified of the winner by April 1, 2010. The winner will be announced at the 2010 CEC-NCDCDT Spring Transition Conference. The Executive Board of the CEC – NCDCDT will assist with press releases, if needed.

The winner and the individual nominating him/her will be invited to the North Carolina Spring NCDCDT Transition Conference for a special ceremony honoring all award recipients. The 2011 conference registration fee for the winner will be waived.
